


# Why Flashcards?

In the first six years of life, your child's brain is operating in a relaxed, absorbent state—open to learning through images, rhythm, and emotion. During this time, the right brain is dominant. It captures information like a camera and stores it deeply when input is **gentle, joyful, and free of pressure**.

Flashcards are one of the simplest and most effective tools for offering this type of input. They provide short, focused bursts of real-world vocabulary, math patterns, and rich imagery—**all delivered with love**. When used with kindness and rhythm, flashcards become seeds of knowledge, gently planted into the subconscious mind.

TweedleWink flashcard time is not about memorization or performance. It's about exposure, bonding, **and joy!**


# What This Flashcard Set Includes

This mini flashcard kit contains 24 printable A4 pages—**48 flashcards total**—to get you started:

- 1. Math Dots (1–10)**      Magenta dot patterns introducing early quantity recognition
- 2. Music Notes (C–C)**      Single-letter representations of musical notes, color-coded, in scale order
- 3. Colors**      12 basic color names
- 4. Shapes**      10 early geometry forms including point, line, and simple shapes
- 5. Clothing**      8 common clothing items

Each card offers high-quality input to stimulate visual memory, language development, and classification skills.


# What This Flashcard Set Includes

# How to Prepare Your Flashcards

1. **Print** your flashcards in full color on thick paper or card stock for durability.

2. **Cut** each sheet in half to separate the two cards.

3. **Label the back of each card** using the format below:

- Write the English word again
- Include translations in other languages (optional but highly recommended)
  - **KINDLY NOTE:** *Some languages are written in different scripts; consider using clear, large fonts for legibility and go online to listen to how each word is pronounced if you're unfamiliar with it!*

4. **Laminate** your cards to protect them from wear and tear. This makes them easy to wipe and reuse daily.

# How to Expand Your Flashcard Set

As your child grows, you can add new flashcards to widen their mental library.

Consider adding:

- Animals, fruits, body parts, tools
- Famous landmarks or people
- Vocabulary from world languages you are introducing
- Geography (continents, oceans, countries)

Use magazines, catalogs, calendars, postcards, printouts, or your own drawings.


Always keep them clear, bright, and joyful.

Laminate new cards for durability and make your own custom collections.

# How to Present Flashcards

1. **Create a Calm Space** Choose a quiet moment—perhaps after a nap, bath, or during breakfast.
2. **Sit at Eye Level** Make sure your child can see your face and the card.
3. **Flash with Rhythm** Flash through 5–10 cards at a time in a soft, consistent rhythm (about one card per second).
4. **Speak with Love** Use a warm tone. Smile. Enjoy it, without expectation.
5. **Don't Test** No need to ask, “What’s this?” Just show and enjoy. Let the gentle exposure do the work.
6. **Use Flash-Match-Play** After you flash, play a watching game with picture cards or objects. Then play—act it out, sing about it, or use it in pretend play.
7. **Rotate and Refresh** Change sets weekly. Keep it novel and engaging.


